7.	To explore scope for Industry- academia collaborations	Looking for scope for student training and employment by establishing collaborations

8.	To promote innovation and entrepreneurship for students.	Promoting the innovation and entrepreneurship potential of the students by making the innovation and entrepreneurship cell more functional, installing and operating startup units for student orientation towards entrepreneurship.
