






How well the teachers were able to communicate? 1,123 responses




The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as 1,123 responses



Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers 1,123 responses




Was your performance with the assignment discussed with you? 1,123 responses








The teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth






Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes
















Teachers encourage you to participate in extra-curricular activities 1,123 responses


