Bhagat Singh Birthday Celebrations: Students, staff and management of Lyallpur Khalsa College remembered Shaheed Bhagat Singh in a brief function held in the college campus to mark the birth anniversary of the martyr on 27.09.2018. This function was organized by Department of History and over 100 students were present on this occasion.
