**Event Guidelines**

**Event 1: Think in Slides**

1. Participants are required to bring their presentations in their own pen drive.
2. Maximum of **two** teams per college are allowed.
3. Each team will consist of **two** participants.
4. Time of 4-6 mins will be given to each team.
5. First bell will ring after 4 mins and final bell after 6 mins.
6. There will be provision of multimedia projector.
7. The presentation should be in English only.
8. Topics for paper presentation are :
  - Digital Identity & Secure Authentication Systems
  - Predictive Analytics for Disaster Management
  - Applications of Artificial Intelligence in field of Education
  - Smart Wearable Technology for Health Monitoring

**Event 2: Toons Mania**

1. Participants can design cartoon using Corel draw/Adobe Photoshop.
2. Maximum of **two** teams per college are allowed.
3. Each team will consist of **two** participants.
4. The topic will be given on the spot.
5. Time allotted is 90 mins.

**Event 3: Web Craft**

1. Participants will be required to develop a web portal.
2. Maximum of **two** teams per college are allowed.
3. Each team will consist of **two** participants.
4. Time limit will be 90 minutes.
5. VS Code Editor will be provided with internet access.
6. Theme of the web portal will be given on the spot.
7. Judgment will be based on UI Design, AI Integration, Functionality, Innovation and Presentation.

**Event 4: AI Matrix**

1. Participants will be required to develop a module using any programming languages and AI tool.
2. **Two** teams per college shall be allowed
3. Each team can comprise of **two** participants.
4. VS Code Editor will be provided with internet access.
5. Time limit will be 90 mins.
6. Problem will be given on the spot.
7. Judgment will be based on Functionality, Innovation and Presentation.

**Event 5: Brain Bits**

1. The participants have to take an IT related objective type **online** test.
2. Maximum of **five** teams per college are allowed.
3. Only **one** participant per team is permitted.
4. Duration of test will be 15 minutes.

### **Event 6: Sketch-O-Vision**

1. The participants have to bring a pre created poster/painting/illustration (use A3 sheet) on
  - **Cyber Security**
  - **AI and Future Tech**
2. Maximum of **two** teams per college are allowed.
3. Only **one** participant per team is permitted.

### **Event 7: Brain Wars**

1. The topic for group discussion will be given on the spot.
2. Maximum of **two** teams per college are allowed.
3. Only **one** participant per team is permitted.
4. Total time allotted will be 60 minutes.

### **Event 8: Tech Trivia**

1. Maximum of **one** team per college is allowed.
2. **Three students** per team shall be allowed.
3. All 3 members of team have to appear in screening test containing questions from different domains of Computer Science & IT.
4. Top four teams will appear for Finals of Quiz.

### **Event 9: Digi Drama**

1. The topic for presenting advertisement will be given at the registration counter.
2. Maximum of **one** team per college is allowed.
3. A team can comprise of minimum of **three** and maximum of **five** participants.
4. No vulgar demonstration.
5. Time of 4-6 mins will be given to each team to perform.
6. First bell will ring after 4 mins and final bell after 6 mins.
7. Judgment will be based on idea generation and presentation.

### **Event 10: Shutter Spark**

1. Each participant is required to submit 3 best photographs shot by him/her at the time of event.
2. Maximum of **two** teams per college are allowed.
3. Each team shall comprise of **one** participant.
4. Student must bring his/her own Digital Camera / Mobile Phone.
5. The theme for this event will be given by the teacher in-charge at the time of registration.

### **Event 11: Beat Blast**

1. The dance can be Primitive, Western Group Dance, Fusion or Indian Folk like Bhangra, Luddi, Sammi, Jhumar.
2. Maximum of **one** team per college is allowed.
3. Each team shall comprise of **4-6** participants.
4. Time Limit: 5-10 minutes.
5. The song must not include indecent or obscene wording.
6. Only recorded music is allowed. Participating team must bring their audio in pen drive.
7. The participants will be responsible for their own music.
8. Judgment will be based on rhythm, coordination, costumes and properties used.
