He also remained the Patron of NRI Sabha and Chairperson of Amateur Kabbadi Federation of India.

Becoming the President of the Governing Council in the year 1973, he left a deep imprint on Lyallpur Khalsa College. As President of the Trust, he gave a new shape to the college which evolved into an internationally acclaimed institution under his dynamic leadership. He continued to guide and steer Khalsa College Lyallpur Group of Institutes till the year 2008 during which the various institutions of the Trust gained prominence in the field of education. He is well remembered for his immense contribution to the world of academics.

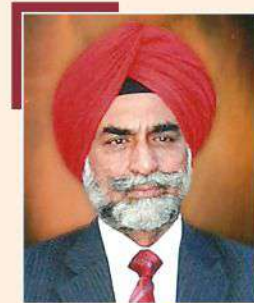

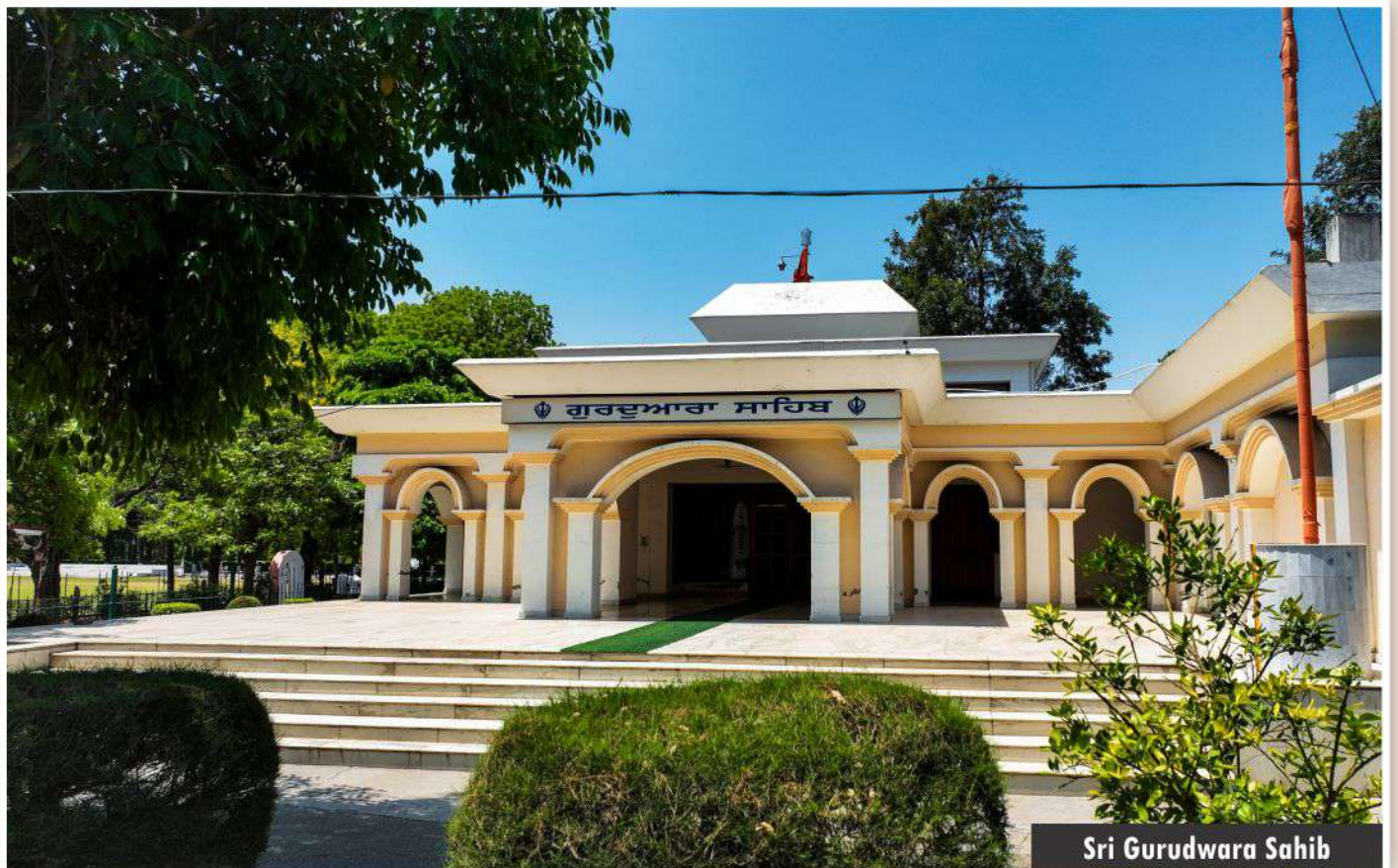

CODE OF CONDUCT

To foster a sense of discipline among the students a code of conduct has been laid down by the College. The institution expects the students to observe this code of conduct strictly.

1. No student will be allowed to enter the college premises without the College Identity Card.
2. Students should be regular as attendance is compulsory in classes and all GNDU rules and regulations apply in this regard. They must maintain discipline and decorum in and outside the classrooms. They should be polite, regular and punctual in their behaviour.
3. Students are advised not to stand in groups in the passage and thus obstruct the movement of others in the college.
4. Quarrels and disputes should be avoided and self-restraint should be exercised. In the event of a dispute, a written complaint should be made to the Principal at once.
5. No damage to the College property will be condoned under any circumstances.
6. Students are expected to keep aloof from active politics as it adversely affects their academic pursuits.
7. Students are required to apply for leave whenever they are unable to attend the class.

Students who are found guilty of infringement of code of conduct shall be liable to punishment in the form of fine, expulsion from the college and withdrawal of admission from the University depending on the seriousness of the offence. On top of all, the college can refuse admission to such students in the coming years.

Lyallpur Khalsa College, Jalandhar is a premier historical educational institution of Northern India dedicated to selfless-service of humanity. ADMISSION CELL

To facilitate the entire process of admission for the students, a dedicated Admission Cell has been established near the entrance of the college where representatives from all the departments guide, counsel and assist students about the available courses, eligibility, admission process, scholarships, facilities and other information needed by the students. Students are advised to visit Admission Cell for any assistance required.

ADMISSION RULES AND GENERAL GUIDELINES

- The Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any student without assigning any reason.
- Admission to the college is made provisionally at the sole risk and responsibility of the student and is subject to the subsequent approval of GNDU. If approval to the admission is withheld by the competent authority for the reason that the student has failed to provide the required information or document in time/has hidden some information/given false information/is not eligible to join the class otherwise, the entire responsibility in such a case will lie with the student himself/herself. No claim whatsoever will be admissible in such a case.
- Admission to different courses is made as per eligibility conditions of Guru Nanak Dev University.
- Admission to various courses will be made strictly on the basis of merit or first come first serve basis.
- Candidates whose results are to be declared late can seek admission in the next higher class provisionally subject to the availability of seat and approval of the university.

ADMISSION THROUGH CENTRALISED PORTAL

Initiatives are being taken to implement the instructions of the Punjab Government to admit the students through online Centralised Portal, the instructions of which are available on <https://admission.punjab.gov.in>. Students are being advised to carefully read and follow the instructions issued by the Govt, University and College from time to time in this regard and contact representatives in the Admission Cell for latest updates.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

To secure Eligibility Certificate, students should apply to the GNDU on prescribed form with the required fee alongwith following documents:

- Original Certificates and DMC of the lower classes passed.
- Original Migration Certificate from the board/university from where the candidate has passed his/her lower examination.

Note: Eligibility Certificate is must for admission in B.A./B.Sc./BCA/ B.Com/BBA/MA/M.Sc. /M.Com part-I & Post Graduate Diplomas.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR MANUAL ADMISSION FOR EXISTING STUDENTS

- Original certificates and marksheets of the lower examination passed.
- Attested Xerox copies of these documents along with the completed admission form.
- Four passport size photographs, two for the admission form and one for the Identity Card and one extra.
- A Copy of Aadhar Card.
- Student belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe, Backward Class must attach required caste certificate with Income certificate issued by the competent authorities along with application to avail benefit of Non-payment of non-refundable charges as per Punjab Govt. Instructions. In event of non-production of required documents, students belonging to the relevant category will not be eligible for this exemption.
- Eligibility certificate from Guru Nanak Dev University for the students who have passed their qualifying examination from Institutions other than GNDU, Panjab University, Punjabi University or PSEB.
 - ★ Admission of students who fail to submit Eligibility Certificate by the required dates shall stand cancelled without any further notice.
 - ★ Students whose result is declared late should submit the Eligibility Certificate within 15 days of the declaration of the result.

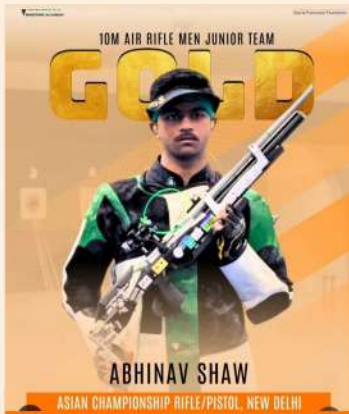

3. ਇਸ ਸਕਾਲਰਸ਼ਿਪ ਦਾ ਲਾਭ ਲੈਣ ਲਈ ਆਮਦਨ ਦਾ ਸਰਟੀਫਿਕੇਟ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਦੇ ਪਿਤਾ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਦੇਣਾ ਲਾਜ਼ਮੀ ਹੈ। ਜੇਕਰ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਦੇ ਪਿਤਾ ਦੀ ਮੌਤ ਹੋ ਚੁੱਕੀ ਹੈ ਤਾਂ ਪਿਤਾ ਦੀ ਮੌਤ ਸੰਬੰਧੀ ਸਰਟੀਫਿਕੇਟ ਦਸਤਾਵੇਜ਼ਾਂ ਦੇ ਨਾਲ ਲਗਾਇਆ ਜਾਵੇ ਜਾਂ ਪਿਤਾ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਆਮਦਨ ਦਾ ਸਰਟੀਫਿਕੇਟ ਨਾ ਦੇਣ ਦਾ ਕੋਈ ਸਬੂਤ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਜਾਵੇ।
4. ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਦੀਆਂ ਕਲਾਸਾਂ ਵਿੱਚ 75% ਹਾਜ਼ਰੀਆਂ ਜ਼ਰੂਰੀ ਹਨ।

RAGGING IN ANY FORM OR MANNER IS STRICTLY BANNED IN THE COLLEGE

Any student indulging in ragging shall be liable to exemplary punishment as per the orders of the Supreme Court and the guidelines of UGC.

What constitutes Ragging: Ragging constitutes one or more of the following acts:

- (a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- (b) Including in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension there of in any fresher or any other student;
- (c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- (d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- (e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of student;
- (f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- (g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- (h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other students;
- (i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student; With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Punishment for Ragging

- i. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- ii. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- iii. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- iv. Withholding results.
- v. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- vi. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- vii. Cancellation of admission.
- viii. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
- ix. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
